[PITTSBURGH, PA – June 2, 2008] SPACE will present the exhibit “You Are Here” opening on Friday, June 27, 2008, and continuing through Saturday, August 9, 2008. This exhibit includes the work of 11 artists addressing the concept of place through a variety of mediums and approaches. There will be an opening reception on Friday, June 27, from 5:30-9 p.m. An artist talk will be held on Saturday, June 28, at 1 p.m. All events are free and open to the public.

The artists employ forms of representation ranging from literal depiction to expressive interpretation to symbolic mark-making. In some cases the places depicted are real, in some cases they are remembered, and in some cases they are imagined. The artists in this exhibit represent place as both complex and fundamental, with the characteristics and qualities of place eliciting our perceptions and shaping our experience in the world.
